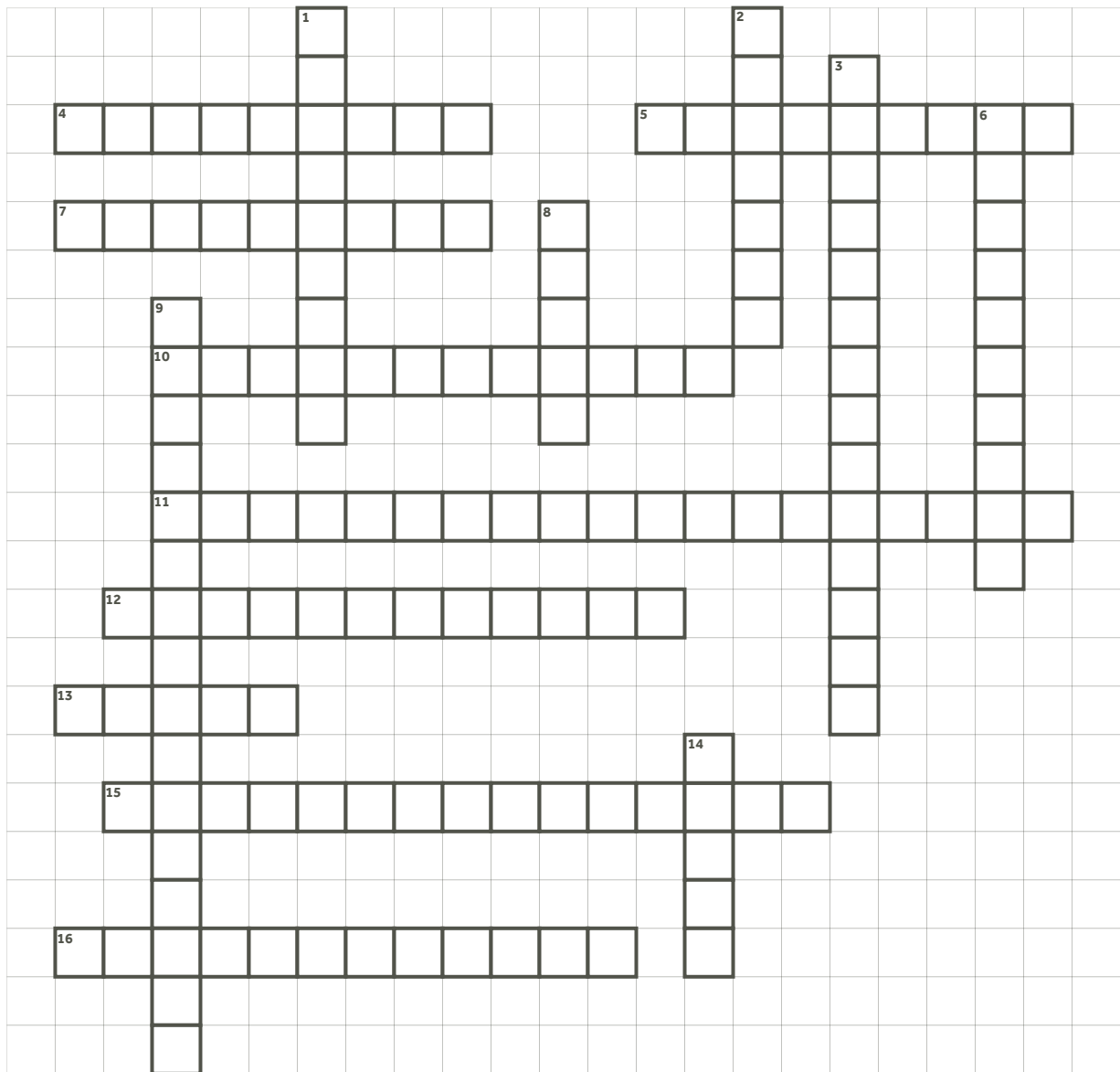


Stations Crossword

4. This station exits onto Sheaf Square.
5. The town that this station serves is the home of the oldest theme park in Mainland UK.
7. This station on the Crewe-Derby line is a stone's throw away from a famous racecourse.
10. This station lies between Beeston and Long Eaton.
11. (4,8,7) Has the station code EMD.
12. A statue of 'Father of the Railways', George Stephenson stands outside this station.
13. This station is located close-by to Pride Park Football Stadium.
15. (6,2,7) Poet, Sir John Betjeman lead a campaign to save this station from demolition in the 1960s.
16. This East Midlands station serves a town famous for its sporting University.

1. A statue of famous travel agent, Thomas Cook stands outside this station.
2. A station on the Derwent Valley Line.
3. Has the station code WEL.
6. This station suffered serious damage from a fire in 2018.
8. Has the station code LUT.
9. (6,10) A new, longer platform opened at this station in February 2020 as part of the Midland Main Line Upgrade.
14. A major interchange station with 12 platforms.
